Evaluation:

To receive the credits, the students in this stage need to decide whether or not they will take the real exam.

- If going for the real C1 Advanced exam, it is enough to send the confirmation of the application or registration to my email. C1 Advanced exam can be either arranged for the students or they can arrange the exam themselves (e.g. in a language school), however, in both cases, the students pay for the exam!
- If **finishing the course with a Mock test**, the students must sit the whole C1 Advanced practice test in the classroom during the examination period (note: the test lasts approximately 4 hours).

In such a case, it is evaluated as follows: Reading and Use of English: max 40 points Listening: max. 20 points Speaking: max. 20 points Writing: max. 20 points To pass, the students taking the Mock test must reach at least 60% out of 100%, counted from all of the parts of the exam.
